*Do not be afraid, "You see Jesus of Nazareth, who was crucified, He is Risen! He is not here. See the Place where they laid Him."*

Mark 16:6

When the women came to the tomb of Jesus that first Easter morning nearly two thousand years ago, they heard Good News from an Angel. Good News of comfort, "Do not be afraid", the Lord always wants to calm our Fears. The first words of the Angel on the night of Christ's birth are the same here on resurrection morning. Good News of coming - the Angel knew that they were seeking to find the body of the crucified Messiah. The Lord knows when we are seeking to come to Him - for He is seeking to come to us.
