

Are You Shining?

As a Child of God, you have a simple but amazing calling for your life. Your call is to know Jesus and make Him known to everyone you meet. To put it another way, you are to shine for Jesus and share Him with the world. This is what God chose you for, called you to and equips you to do. You may be wondering just how am I to do this? The answer is through the power of the Holy Spirit. Before Jesus ascended to Heaven, He gathered His followers and told them not to leave Jerusalem but to wait for what the Father had promised. Then Jesus said to His disciples in Acts 1:8, "but you will receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be My witnesses both in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and even to the remotest part of the earth." Do not miss this biblical promise where the Holy Spirit empowers you to shine for Jesus and share Him with the world. Yes, It is through the promise of Christ that we will be filled and are made capable to shine in this world!

Jesus said, "I am the light of the world." And Jesus promises that when He comes into your life, you become the light of the world through His Spirit. When the Holy Spirit lives in your human spirit, His light fills your life. That means you have supernatural power to love and live like you never could before. The Spirit of God is within you, the same Spirit through whom Jesus lived a life of perfect righteousness. If your walk does not match your talk, you become a hypocrite who says one thing and does another. On the other hand, if you have a godly life but you never tell anybody about the One who fills you with His love, bystanders will have difficulty understanding where the power comes from. Our call from Christ is clear, we must shine and share. To do that, you need to know the story. Every Christian should know the gospel story and be able to share it with another person. I know it can be hard to overcome our fears, shyness, and hesitations, but that is why God gives you power through His Holy Spirit. You are not in this alone! As a believer in Jesus, the Holy Spirit lives in you to empower you to fulfill your Kingdom purpose which is to shine for Jesus and share Him with the world. So, my question to you today would be, are you shining, and are you sharing Jesus?


