"Forward 2022"

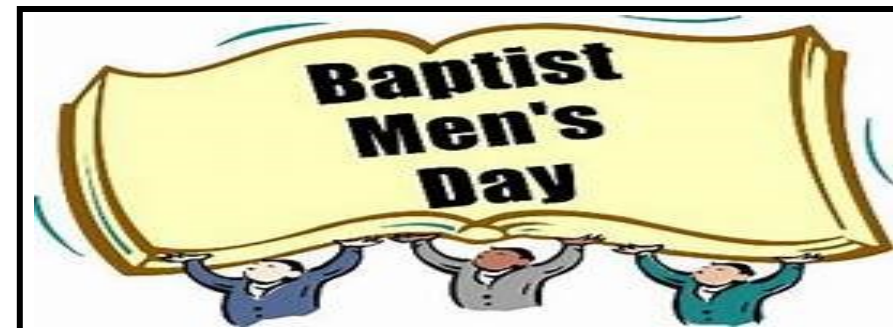
