PASTOR'S ARTICLE

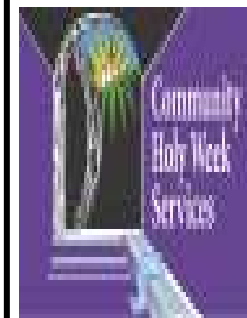
"Will you not revive us again, that Your people may rejoice in You?"

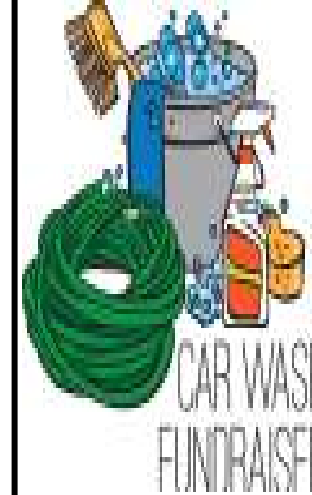
