"I do not pray for these only, but also for those who will believe in me through their word."

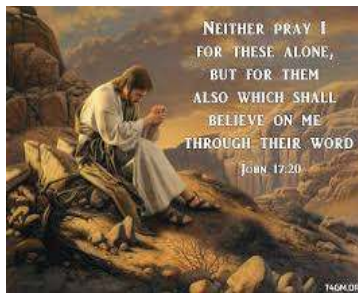
John 17:20
